We design, test, field, collect, analyze, and publish survey results to fill evidence and knowledge gaps with Patient Experience Data.



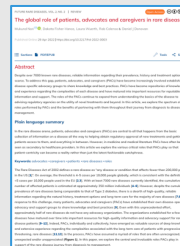
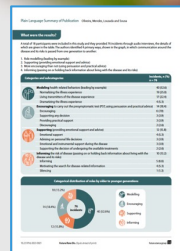
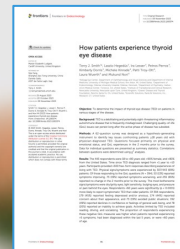
PLAIN LANGUAGE SUMMARIES
